FLORIDA SUMMER LEARNING DAY

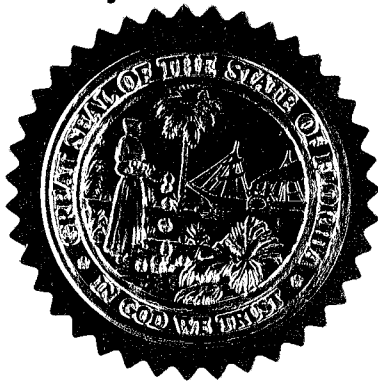
